Career Source to place four laborers to assist the City with storm cleanup. Laborers will be funded through the National Dislocated Worker Grant for Hurricane Michael.

December 6th attended a Emergency Management Local Mitigation Strategy Meeting with City Administrator, City Clerk, and CAAB Chair. Storm water management projects were submitted.
