

NOTICE OF CDBG PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISASTER RECOVERY INFRASTRUCTURE

The City of Carrabelle is applying for Rebuild Florida General Infrastructure Repair Program funding in the amount of three million seven hundred sixty-eight thousand two hundred sixty-three dollars (\$3,768,263.00) provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to assist the State of Florida in recovering from the effects of Hurricane Michael the 2018 Storm Event. This funding will be administered by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) and can only be used for selected activities that are directly related to the disaster or for disaster mitigation. Activities that are typically eligible for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program are eligible projects if no other funding is available to meet the need. Applications are due in DEO no later than September 17, 2021.

The City of Carrabelle intends to submit four applications which will rehabilitate and repair sanitary sewer lines, manholes and laterals to address stormwater and storm surge Inflow and Infiltration into the City's Sanitary Sewer system. The City anticipates submitting applications for the following facilities:
